

Overall Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 overall male and female finishers in the Half Marathon, scored using GUN time.

Masters Awards (ages 40 and over): Awards will be given to the top male and female Overall masters in the Half Marathon, scored using GUN time.

Age Group Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 male and female finishers in each age group for the Half Marathon, scored using CHIP time. This allows each runner to be scored against all other runners in their age group, regardless of where they start. Age Groups: 19 & Under, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+

10K

Overall Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 overall men and women finishers in the 10K, scored using GUN time.

Age Group Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 male and female finishers in each age-group, scored using CHIP time. Age Groups: 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75+

5K

Overall Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 overall men and women finishers in the 5K, scored using GUN time.

Age Group Awards: Awards will be given to the top 3 male and female finishers in each age-group, scored using CHIP time. Age Groups: 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75+

NOTE: If you are planning to be in contention for one of the overall or masters awards, please start at the front. Overall winners are removed from their respective age groups and are not eligible for Age Group Awards.

There will be no awards ceremony. If you are eligible to receive an award, you may pick it up at the Awards Podium located near the Challenge and Results Tent. Award distribution times: 10K: 8:15am, 5K: 9:45am, Half Marathon: 9:30am. You may also check your results by scanning the QR Code that is posted on signs throughout the venue.
