



# TIMING & RESULTS

## TIMING TECHNOLOGY

Our official timer, The Last Mile Racing, uses a MYLAPS disposable RFID tag (chip) that adheres to the back of the participant's bib number to record their time. Your chip will be recorded by timing mats at the start line and finish line. There will be additional timing mats at the farthest points on the course.

**To receive an accurate time, please confirm your bib is:**

- Clearly visible on the **FRONT** of the torso.
- Unaltered or modified. **Do not fold or wrinkle** or you risk breaking the timing chip.
- Pinned in all four corners so the timing chip stays flat.
- **Not covered** with jackets, water bottles, etc., so as not to block the reading of the timing chip.

## LIVE TRACKING & RESULTS

St Pete Run Fest features the latest in real-time race tracking! Features include:

- **Live Web Tracker** – see times and current pace within seconds of a participant crossing each split point. Estimated times will be provided based on current pace.
- **Live Leaderboard** – see who's winning with top runners in each category displayed in real-time as they run the course.
- **Live Map Tracking** – Participant locations will be plotted on the Interactive Course Map as they move on the course, estimated based on the most recent timing mat reads from the course. NOTE: Participants do not need to carry a phone for this feature.
- **Mobile App** – features Live Participant Tracking, Push Notifications, Leaderboards, Map Tracking, Event information and messages, and more.

If you set a PR (personal record), be sure to go ring the **PR Bell** at the Regenexx tent.

There will be no awards ceremony. Awards will be handed out at the **INFO/AWARDS TENT** as soon as the timer provides a final/corrected set of results. There will be an awards podium & backdrop next to the INFO/AWARDS TENT to take photos. Approximate award times are 8:15am for the 10K, 9:45am for the 5K, and 9:30am for the Half Marathon.

***\*Overall winners will be taken out of the running for masters and age group awards  
there will be no double-dipping\****

## 10K

**Overall Awards:** will be given to the top 3 overall men, women, and non-binary finishers in the 10K, scored using GUN time. **Age Group Awards:** will be given to the top 3 men and women finishers in each age-group, scored using CHIP time. Age Groups: 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+

## 5K

**Overall Awards:** will be given to the top 3 overall men, women, and non-binary finishers in the 5K, scored using GUN time. **Age Group Awards:** will be given to the top 3 men and women finishers in each age-group, scored using CHIP time. Age Groups: 14 & under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+

## HALF MARATHON

**Overall Awards:** will be given to the top 3 overall men, women, and non-binary finishers in the Half Marathon, scored using GUN time. **Masters Awards (ages 40 and over):** will be given to the top man and woman masters in the Half Marathon, scored using GUN time. **Age Group Awards:** will be given to the top 3 men and women finishers in each age group for the Half Marathon, scored using CHIP time. This allows each runner to be scored against all other runners in their age group, regardless of where they start. Age Groups: 19 & Under, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80+. **NOTE:** *There is an elite group of 20 runners who will be escorted to the front at the start line prior to the start. If you are planning to be in contention for one of the overall or masters awards, you should position yourself near the front.*

## HALF MARATHON RELAY

Relay Team members will receive an individual time for their segment and a combined team time. **Overall Awards** for fastest Male, Female, and Mixed Team, based on combined team CHIP times.

## CHALLENGES (Tortuga, Dolphin, Stingray)

Although results will show top 5 overall rankings for the challenges (based on combined times of 2-3 races), **there are no awards for the challenges**, except for the TOUGHEST TORTUGA (fastest man and woman in the Tortuga Triple Challenge).
